



- Illegal possession of <u>drugs</u> is a crime in New Jersey.
- Drugs are classified into several categories based on their likelihood to lead to negative activities or bad health.



Drugs Classification



Schedule I

- Drugs that are not used in the medical field fall under Schedule I.
- Example: Heroin, marijuana, mescaline and peyote



Schedule II

• Any drug that is an opiate or contains coca is Schedule II.

Use of these drugs can lead to mental problems and addiction.




Schedule III

- Schedule III drugs can be used for medical purposes, but excess use of these drugs can lead to mental and physical dependency.
- Example: Amphetamine and ketamine



Schedule IV

- Even excessive use of some medical drugs may lead to low level dependency.
- Example: Barbital



Schedule V

- Schedule V drugs have medical uses and limited danger of physical dependence when compared to other categories.
- Example: Codeine
